Euaggelion = good news or a good message

Euaggelizo = to announce
or bring good news

Euaggelistes = one who brings good news

preach good tidings to the poor**; He has
sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To
proclaim liberty to the captives, And the
opening of the prison to those who are
bound; Isaiah 61:1

Instead of your shame you shall have double honor, And instead of confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double; **Everlasting joy shall be theirs.** "For I, the Lord, love justice; I hate robbery for burnt offering; I will direct their work in truth, And **will make with them an everlasting covenant.** Isaiah 61:7,8

I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, My soul shall be joyful in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, As a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, And as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. For as the earth brings forth its bud, As the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth, So the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations. Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things which you hear and see: "The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and **the poor have the (good news) preached to them.** Matthew

He sent them **to preach the kingdom of God** and to heal the sick. 6 So they departed and went through the towns, **preaching the (good news)** and healing everywhere. Luke 9:2,6

So when they had testified and preached the word of the Lord, they returned to Jerusalem, **preaching the (good news)** in many villages Acts 8: 25 also Acts 14:7; 14:21; 16:10;

And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the (good news) to Abraham beforehand, saying, "In you all the nations shall be blessed." (Gen. 12:3) So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham.

Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it. For indeed **the (good news) was preached to us as well as to them**; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with **faith** in those who heard it.
